

Preparatory course for flight attendants

KUCHING, Sat. - A preparatory course for flight attendants commenced at the Crowne Plaza Riverside today with eight participants.

"There were supposed to be 12 for this first intake but four had to work on Saturday," said the instructor for effective communication skills, Hilary Miranda, who added that the four will be joining the class tomorrow.

The course, organised by Excel Language Services which has offices in Penang and Johor Bahru, is meant for people who aspire to secure a career with airlines as a flight attendants.

Excel manager Chong Siew Fong said the course topics will cover body language, the preparation of resume, interview practice, grooming, posture, make-up, hair style and attires.

Aptitude tests and mock interviews will be conducted as well.

Chong urged those who lacked communication skills, confidence and other qualities, especially those who aspire to be employed as a flight attendant, to register for the course.

The participants will also be taught on the responsibilities in embarking in a career as a

flight attendant during the five sessions conducted by former flight attendants from MAS airline and Hilary, a language specialist.

Hilary also mentioned that besides preparing the candidates for a career with the airlines, there is a free oral English class being conducted for all participants.
